



SI (IT) and ASI (GD).**

1. Medical Check-Up.

Medical Test examination shall commence on 24/09/18 from 07:00AM onwards at Police Complex, Chumukedima.

(a) Height.

- (i) Male Candidates - 5'-3" (162 CM)
- (ii) Female Candidates - 5' (152 CM)

(b) Chest

- (i) Male Candidates - Normal- 31" (79 CM)
Expanded- 33" (84 CM)
- (ii) Female Candidates - Normal-29" (74 CM)
Expanded- 31" (79CM)

(c) Weight: As per the prescribed medical chart of weight obtained from the Directorate of Medical services, height and weight are co-related. Following chart shall be used for both male and female candidates.

(d) Disqualification:

The following physical conditions shall disqualify the candidate which will be applicable to both male and female candidates.

- (a) Eye-Sight: A person having colour blindness.
Eye-sight below minimum distance vision of 6/6 and 6/9 of both eyes without correction.
- (b) Knocked knees
- (c) Flat footed
- (d) Squint eye condition
- (e) Amputated limb/Extremities
- (f) Physical deformities
- (g) Deaf or hard of hearing.

(2) Physical Efficiency Test.

Selected candidates who qualify the medical test examination shall be required to undergo Physical Proficiency Test (PPT) .

(3) Written Examination.

The written examination shall be conducted on completion of Medical and Physical Test which shall be duly intimated to the qualified candidates in the Notice Board of Main RP Gate, Police Complex, Chumukedima.
